#### Housing:

- 1. Naburn Hall Lodge built.
- 2. River View built
- 3. Sewage Works cottages
- 4. Railway Cottages
- Ash Villa

### Agricultural:

- 1. Windpump
- 2. Buildings behind Maypole Grove demolished?
- 3. Sheds by Shepherd's House
- 4. Second fishing lodge appears on Acaster Malbis side
- 5. Howden Dike entrance to River Ouse gains a bridge and appears tidier
- 6. Second river access opposite today's snicket disappears
- 7. Leaf's Rush renamed Rush
- 8. Field garden allotments disappeared

### Industrial:

- 1. Railway
- 2. Gas works
- 3. Second lock at Naburn Locks
- 4. Sewage works

#### Miscellaneous:

- 1. Church built
- 2. Vicarage built
- 3. Methodist chapel moved to new building (replaces houses/sheds?)
- 4. School moves from Pear Tree Cottage to current location
- 5. Trees on foreshore by Ferry Farm Cottages have gone
- 6. York Asylum built
- Golf course arrived

## Other Points of Interest:

- 1. Howden Dike route changed along Howden Lane between 1910 and now
- 2. Moor End cottages (almshouses) still there in 1910
- 3. Meaning of W (Naburn Hall, Busk Fields etc)?
- 4. Meaning of P (York Road, Naburn Grange, 2 at Naburn Locks)?
- 5. Farm/House name changes Ireland House, Naburn Hill, Naburn Lodge
- 6. River milestones are they still there?
